

**NOMATA  
BOARD MINUTES**

**September 27, 2009**

Meeting called to order by Chris Dazet @ 1:35 p.m.

**In Attendance:** Chris Dazet, Henry Crocker and Guy Curry.

**Minutes:** August 23, 2009 Minutes read; Motion made by Guy and seconded by Henry to adopt as accurately reported.

**Junior Team Tennis Report:** Chris reported that the Juniors' Fall program is under way with an increase in participation this year. Chris also reported that, beginning in 2010, all 10 and younger Juniors' USTA tournaments will be set up and played in accordance with the QuickStart Program format.

**Marketing:**

- Chris will order 1000 squeeze bottles with NOMATA logo for use for promotion in conjunction with the Juniors'/Diversity program events planned in November, 2009.

**Old Business:**

- Chris to remind Cathy Lago that NOMATA still needs a Grant Request form downloaded from NOMATA website in conjunction with QuickStart program request to secure necessary equipment for Bissonet program, namely 3-21" junior rackets, 3-23" junior rackets and 1 bucket of balls (cost \$69.00), for Bissonet location, to run for 10 weeks ending August 8, 2009 and to consist of 16 – 5 & 6 years olds, 20 – 7&8 year olds, and 20- 9&10 year olds.

**New Business:**

- Motion made by Henry and seconded by Guy to schedule Adult Fun, Friends & Fitness Program on six Mondays from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. and two Saturdays from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m., with a round robin tournament to conclude the program on November 14<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. Courts will be utilized at Colonial Country Club, UNO and City Park. Participation is limited to Adult beginners up to the USTA 2.5-rated level. Cost will be \$60.00 for all eight sessions (\$5/hour) to include 12 hours of instruction by certified tennis pros, or participants can attend one session for \$15.00 (\$10/hour). Henry has produced a flyer which will be disseminated locally. Information should be posted on NOMATA website. NOMATA promotional squeeze bottles will be distributed to participants in the round robin tournament on November 14<sup>th</sup>.

- Motion made by Henry and seconded by Guy to schedule a “Youth Tennis Carnival” as a combined Juniors’ and Diversity Program on Saturday, November 21<sup>st</sup> from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at either City Park or UTC. Refreshments are to be served and NOMATA promotional squeeze bottles will be distributed to participants.
- Henry raised the idea that NOMATA serve as a repository for local high tennis match results on its website, as there exists no central location for such information in the area. In addition to serving the local school programs, this would serve as a means of promoting NOMATA through utilization of its website for these purposes.
