

# NOMATA Minutes

The following board members attended the NOMATA board meeting on Sunday, November 20, 2006 – Pedro Docampo, Kathy Hinrichs, Lynda Santopadre, Suzette Watson, Orlando Watkins, and Carla Catalano.

**President's Agenda** - Pedro Docampo said that he had received the QuickBooks file from Trey via e-mail, had picked up from Trey's mailbox the Whitney bank statements, the other NOMATA checkbook, and the Whitney online ID and password. Trey offered to help Pedro with the QuickBooks training if needed over the Thanksgiving holiday weekend.
